RULES & GUIDELINES

TEAM SPECIFICATION:

• A team may consist of a maximum of 4 participants, all from the same institute or may be from different institutes.

- Registration fees are Rs. 299 per team.
- Team Name:- Every team must have a name which must be unique.
- Organizers reserve the right to reject entries from any team whose name they deem inappropriate, offensive or conflicting.

BOT SPECIFICATIONS:

- Weight Category: 4kg
- Dimensions: 30cm*25cm*15cm
- Tolerance: 10%
- Battery : Max 4s (14.8V)
- Bot should be fully customised, no readymade rc race bot will be allowed.
- motor type: electric.
- Bot can be wired (length >3m) or wireless.
- The bot cannot be assisted with hands or misplced by external means.
- No modifications allowed after the race starts.

"Penalty time will be imposed on violating the rules"

RULES & GUIDELINES

GAMEPLAY:

• The robot will be placed before the start line.

More than 50% of the robot body should remain inside

- track, otherwise, it has to start from the last checkpoint crossed, timer will not stop in between.
 Penalties will be there for each task skipped. Penalties will be added to the total time.
- The timer will stop as soon as the robot crosses the finish line.
- The bot cannot touch the outline of the track .

PENALTIES:

- For skipping a Task : 30 seconds
- Starting from last checkpoint : 15 seconds
- Touching the outline or any obstacle : 5 seconds

RACE TRACK:

There will be one start and one finish line. The track surface and course line may have unevenness.
There will be certain obstacles in the racetrack, which will try to slow down the robot.
The track may consist of steep ramps, bridges, speed breakers, marble pit, slippery paths, rotating discs, curve rampdown, seesaws, etc.
